

Bursary Exchange Program

In our continual effort to reach out to the community and make art courses available to those who might not necessarily be able to afford them, we have developed the Bursary Exchange program. Students participating in this program work at the School in exchange for art courses and expand their employment experience.

To qualify, interested students must have completed a minimum of two courses at the Vancouver Island School of Art before applying. Application forms must be submitted to the office three weeks before the start date of the semester.

The School facilitates up to two Bursary Exchange students at one time. Accepted students are required to sign a contract, agreeing to work the same number of hours as class time they are enrolled in; hour for hour, in lieu of payment and in exchange for tuition fees payable. Time sheets must be completed on a regular basis.

Bursary Exchange students' work includes classroom preparation, daily tidying and upkeep of the classroom, kitchen area and library, assisting with school events or Slide Room Gallery exhibitions and other school related jobs as required.
