

Vancouver Island School of Art COVID-19 Health Protocols (Fall 2020)

- 1. Daily self screen before entering school for any purpose.**
 - a. Do you present symptoms of a common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other infectious respiratory disease?**
 - b. Have you been in contact with an identified confirmed case or outbreak?**
 - c. Have you been outside Canada in the last 14 days? If the answer is yes to any of these questions, you must stay at home, self-isolate, and seek care from a health-care provider.**

- 2. Hand sanitizing is required upon entry to the school at the provided station at the top of the staircase.**

- 3. One student at a time will be permitted in the office for any service.**

- 4. Students, studio artists, staff and instructors are to wear masks when in common areas such as hallways, staircases and bathrooms.**

- 5. Classroom instruction is limited to 12 students to provide appropriate physical distancing.**
 - a. Each student will have their own table**
 - b. Two-metre physical distancing between student chairs**
 - c. Physical distancing will be maintained during critiques or other situations where students are not in their chairs**

- 6. Instructors will wear protective face shields when physical distancing is not possible.**

- 7. Classrooms have one-way movement through dedicated entrance and exit.**

- 8. All surfaces are sanitized between classes.**
