

Supply List - Drawing: Exploration of Materials DRWG207-36 FA20

Items required for the first class:

- sketch book (or a large piece of paper - 18" x 24" or larger)
- your choice of sketching materials (such as graphite pencils, coloured pencils, charcoal, etc)
- small object with interesting contours (like a shoe, seashell, camera, basket, etc.)
- small towel or blanket that is large enough to cover your object

Additional Items to be discussed during the first class:

- Surfaces:
- pad of newsprint (18" x 24" or larger)
 - 5 sheets of pastel paper (approx. 18" x 24" or larger): 1 black, 1 white, 1 mid-grey, 2 medium-hued pastel paper (any colour)
 - 1 extra large sheet of paper (approximately 42" x 60" or larger)
 - 3 sheets of tracing paper (18" x 24" or larger)
 - selection of drawing papers for in-class exercise and independent projects (suggested: 18" x 24" or larger)
 - cardboard or matt board

Drawing:

- standard white eraser, and/or a pliable eraser
- set of graphite pencils (suggested: 6H – 6B)
- set of coloured pencils (primary and secondary colors)
- markers
- Conté sticks: 1 black, 1 white, 1 medium-hued (any colour)
- 1 or 2 sticks of charcoal
- black India ink
- 1 white oil bar/oil stick (Note: oil bars are not the same as oil pastels)
- 1 medium-hued oil stick (any colour)
- 1 dark-hued oil stick (any colour)
- small box of wax crayons

Painting:

- acrylic paints (primary colours, and white)
- acrylic medium
- watercolours
- plastic container(s) for water
- assortment of brushes

Other Materials:

- spool(s) of thread (any colour)
- spool of pliable wire (any colour)
- utility knife and/or scissors
- metal ruler
- thumb tacks
- binder clips
- masking tape
- portfolio case
